Based on the approved NCA Curricula, Examination Rules and Admission Procedure approved by the BOS of the CSE Deptt.

Examination Rules

(i) Grading system will be introduced with the following marks-grade relationship in each subject.

80% and above	-	A
70% to below 80%	-	B
60% to below 70%	-	C
50% to below 60%	-	D
Below 50%	-	E

(ii) Pass marks will be kept at 50%.

(iii) Lab courses will be treated as Sessional papers with the following rule:

To be eligible to appear in any examination, each student must satisfactorily complete the sessional work, and must obtain at least 50% marks in each of the sessional subjects in every semester.

(iv) All examination in the M.C.A. shall be held on the compartmental system, that is to say, students must pass separately in every paper of the different examinations and those who pass in a paper shall not be permitted to sit for examination in the paper again. Non-appearance in a paper will count as failure in that paper.

(v) Pass marks in all examinations in the M.C.A. shall be 50% of the maximum marks in each paper.

(vi) (1) M.C.A. Examinations will be held in two parts in First and Second Semesters.

(2) Examination for both the First Semester and Second Semester subjects will be held during the First Semester and also during Second Semester Examinations for all the subjects except for Final year subject.

(3) There will be no Supplementary Examinations except for the Final year outgoing students only. Only one Supplementary Examination of all the Papers of the M.C.A. Final (First and Second Semester)

may warrant.

- (x) A student who has appeared at any Repeat Examination in any semester subject or has submitted his thesis as a bi-annual candidate will be placed in the appropriate class in order of merit, but shall be placed below the list of candidates as determined under clause (ix), irrespective of the fact they might have secured higher aggregate marks than the candidates whose merit list has been determined according to the same provision.
- (xi) The Examination Committee for conducting viva-voce of M.C.A. project of each shall be constituted as follows:
 - (a) Supervisor from the Department.
 - (b) One external examiner for each candidate to be recommended by the Head of the Department on the advice of the Supervisor from the Department.
 - (c) Supervisor from the Industry/R&D organization where the project work has been done, (if the work has been done outside the Department) provided the said Supervisor is available at the time of the examination.
- (xii) Students qualifying in the second year examinations in the first attempt and securing at least 60% marks in the aggregate will be eligible for a scholarship of @ Rs. 400/- per month (from July to June) in the 3rd year provided his/her rank on the basis of the second year examination is within the first 30.

2. Admission procedure

(i) Eligibility

University degree (10+2+3) pattern, in Arts/Science/Commerce/Management/Social Sciences with at least 55% marks in Honours/Aggregate as applicable and 60% marks in Engineering/Technology (other than in Computer Sc. & Engg. or equivalent). Mathematics must be one of the subjects of study at the undergraduate level for all candidates.

(ii) Selection Procedure

- (a) There shall be an Entrance Examination for Admission to the M.C.A. programme.
- (b) The Entrance Examination will consist of the following two papers:
