INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHORS

JADAVPUR JOURNAL OF PHILOSOPHY (JJP) invites submission of original scholarly work in all fields of Philosophy. Articles on interdisciplinary themes with philosophical significance are also welcomed. JJP considers all manuscripts on the strict condition that: (i) the manuscript is your own original work; (ii) does not duplicate any other previously published work, including your own previously published work; (iii) it is not under consideration or peer review or accepted for publication or in press or published elsewhere. The contributions must show promise of novelty and the significance of the presented work needs to be properly highlighted. The article must not limit itself to plain literature survey but show potential in situating history of philosophy / philosophical issues in a new way and in a relevant context. Manuscripts are judged on their philosophical merit and their relevance to the field. The editors reserve the right to make editorial changes in manuscripts not involving changes in meaning.

All submissions (in MS Word format [MSOffice 97 and above]) must be sent to jadavjrphil@yahoo.com. Authors using symbols and other technical apparatus should include the relevant fonts in the attachment. The authors must also send the manuscript in a PDF file with embedded fonts, in addition to the MS Word format copy. All articles should be typed, double spaced in 12 points Times New Roman, single column, and numbered consecutively throughout. Manuscripts should not exceed 8000 words including references and bibliography. Manuscripts that greatly exceed this will be returned without review. Authors should include a word count with their manuscript. Abstracts of 150 words are required for all manuscripts submitted. Each manuscript should have 5 to 6 keywords.

Manuscripts should be prepared for anonymous refereeing, with proper acknowledgments and self-identifying references removed. All authors of a manuscript should include their full names, affiliations, postal addresses, telephone numbers and email addresses, title of the paper on the cover page of the manuscript. One author should be identified as the corresponding author. Please note that no changes to affiliation can be made after the manuscript is accepted. Please provide all details required by any funding and grant-awarding bodies as an Acknowledgement on the title page of the manuscript, as follows: For single agency grants: "This work was supported by the [Funding Agency] under Grant [number xxxx]." For multiple agency grants: "This work was supported by the [Funding Agency 1] under Grant [number xxxx]; [Funding Agency 2] under Grant [number xxxx]."

INSTRUCTIONS FOR BOOK PUBLISHERS

Books for review and all related material should be sent to the correspondence address. Submission of books to the Journal does not necessarily guarantee a review or an immediate review.

Style Guidelines: Articles submitted in English should follow the British spelling and punctuation. Please use the double inverted commas for the quotations (and also for the words/phrases), except where "a quotation is 'within' a quotation". Long quotations should be indented without quotation marks. For a short quote, a superscript number is used and a footnote is necessary to indicate the source of the quote. Notes and references should appear at the bottom of the pages as Footnotes. The first time a source is cited, the footnote must provide full bibliographic details. In footnoting a repeat citation, use the author's surname and the page number, if the page number is different from the earlier
