- Have cleared the Ph.D. admission test as well as the interview for any department/school suitable to the proposed area of research, under the Faculty of Arts, and School of Women's Studies, Cognitive Science, Languages and Linguistics, International Relations and Strategic Studies, Cultural Text and Records, Media Communication and Culture under Faculty of ISLM of Jadavpur University, before November 28, 2016.
