

Short-Term Course on Safety Management

From the day of Industrialization, safety in operation of an industry is the prime consideration in location, design, layout, construction, and maintenance. The constant striving for higher productivity, more powerful and efficient machines, greater degree of automation involved, and increasingly complex work schedule has resulted in providing not only better customer satisfaction but also increased safety in production.

Traditionally, both academia and practitioners have intended to address risk by focusing on technical aspects and looking for the immediate causes of accidents or fire incidents after they have taken place. Accident, like Stephen Court Fire, has highlighted the need for addressing safety proactively. As a result of this, organizations are now planning to implement safety principles and educate all-level of employees to maintain and sustain the safety management.

Keeping this in mind, Jadavpur University and Confederation of Indian Industry (CII) propose a 6-day training program for personnel of Industry. The objective of the course is mentioned as follows:

- (i) To put emphasis on management functions, guidelines, national and international standards, quality principles, to establish the safety management system (SMS) of organizations,
- (ii) To see systematic safety management approaches and attempt to address events, including failure, fatality, injury, and property loss so that the risk may be maintained to an acceptable range in the operations of the organization, and
- (iii) To highlight the associated functions and the channels of communication in order to minimize the probability of failure of the system of an organization.

In this background, a 6-day course will be organized from 21 November to 26 November 2022 at Jadavpur University. For more detail, all the interested participants are requested to contact the following persons:
