

**STUDENT EXCHANGE PROGRAMME WITH MOMOYAMA GAKUIN
UNIVERSITY (ST. ANDREW'S UNIVERSITY) OSAKA, JAPAN**

**OPPORTUNITY FOR JU UNDERGRADUATE OR POSTGRADUATE
STUDENTS**

Jadavpur University's SYLFF Steering Committee is going to nominate two students as Exchange Students for the year 2018-19 to Momoyama Gakuin University (St. Andrews University), Osaka, Japan for one full year (two semesters), starting from Fall Semester in September 2018 and ending in Spring Semester in July 2019 under the terms and conditions mentioned in the Memorandum of Understanding for Student Exchange between Jadavpur University (India) and Momoyama Gakuin University (Japan) of 2009. Students are eligible for receiving credits, grade sheets etc. for courses taken in Momoyama Gakuin University.

The students can take various courses in English language on Japanese economy, business management practices in Japan, Japanese culture etc. The list of courses offered in English at Momoyama Gakuin University is given in the attached annexure for the reference of the interested candidates. However, the study of Japanese Language is compulsory during the programme. Apart from this, the students will be attending this programme with about 100 other exchange students from more than 20 different countries of the world, including the United States, Canada, Australia and 12 other countries from Europe and it is indeed a great opportunity to know about the culture and the living of people from all over the world. It should be mentioned here that no pre-requisite of Japan or Japanese language is required to qualify for this programme.

Financial Support and Responsibilities:

- The Exchange students from Jadavpur University, like previous years, are eligible for monthly financial support/scholarship of 80,000 JPY, from Momoyama Gakuin University, which usually meets all their overseas expenses during their stay at Momoyama Gakuin University.
- The students will need to:
 - take care of their travel expenses between India and Japan and daily expenses in Japan during their stay there.
 - pay a semester fee of 40,000 JPY at the beginning of the semester for the programmes, festivals and trips organised for exchange students in the University.
 - pay a total accommodation fee of 4,80,000 JPY for 1 year (2 semesters) and it does not include the Energy Bill (Gas/Electricity/Water Bill).

- In the previous years, exchange students from Jadavpur University could also take up part-time jobs there.

Last Date for Submission of Application and Selection:

Any bona fide student of Jadavpur University intending to take one year extra course work at Momoyama Gakuin University (if credit transfer arrangement cannot be worked out before the candidate's departure) and to attend the listed courses is requested to submit a formal application in plain paper forwarded by the respective HOD.

The applications must include the following details – applicant's name, department, level of study (UG/PG) along with one paragraph stating "Why do you want to take one extra year of course work (if no credit transfer mechanism can be worked out) under this exchange programme?" as well as a brief write up on 'Why are you interested in going to Momoyama Gakuin University?'. Interested candidates should already have their passports and they should also apply for academic transcripts (till the last semester completed under UG/PG programme at Jadavpur University) without any delay after being notified about their selection. Completed applications along with attested copies of certificates, mark sheets and testimonials have to be submitted at the Office of the Joint Registrar (Shri Sanjay Gopal Sarkar), 2nd floor, Aurobindo Bhavan, Jadavpur University, by 20th April, 2018.
